An annual cap on out-of-pocket costs may lower costs for Medicare Part D members.¹ Patients will also have the option to participate in a payment plan that spreads costs out over the plan year.^{1,2}

If You Have Medicare Part D Insurance, Your Prescription Drug Costs May Be Lower in 2025¹

Spending Cap on Part D Prescriptions

Recent changes in law have added a cap on how much Medicare patients need to pay for their Part D medicines. This means you would pay a maximum of \$2000 for your Part D medicines starting in 2025.¹

- Once you've reached the spending cap, CRESEMBA (isavuconazonium sulfate) will cost you \$0 under the Part D benefit
- If you have not yet paid \$2000 for Part D medications in the plan year, you may need to pay your out-of-pocket costs until the spending cap is reached

The spending cap only applies to Medicare Part D. Claims billed through Medicare Part B do not apply towards your Medicare Part D out-of-pocket spending cap.¹

Medicare Part D Prescription Payment Plan

In 2025, all Medicare Prescription Plans* will offer enrollees the option to pay their prescription drug costs through a monthly payment plan.^{1,2}

You can enroll in this monthly payment plan option during your annual enrollment period, which began **October 15, 2024, or at any point during your coverage.**^{2†}
